Types of garbage collected		Examples of garbage	Remarks
Burnable garbage		Food waste, shells, rubber products, vinyl, leather products such as bags, paper scraps, wood chips, diapers, cooking oil, etc., binders (stationery), clothing, albums	- There is a fee (Put the garbage in a designated garbage bag) - Put out food waste after draining it - Disassemble or cut up large objects so that they fit into designated garbage bags - Soak cooking oil into paper or solidify it
Non-burnable garbage		Microwave ovens, dehumidifiers, irons, fans, bucket cans, extension cords, toasters, umbrellas, ski shoes, gas stoves, pots, rice cookers, scoops, vacuum cleaners, electric kettles, VCRs, lighting fixtures, ceramics, mirrors, vases, glass, bottle fragments, tableware, water bottles, cameras, calculators, telephones, clocks, boomboxes, push pins, razors, utility knives, planers, nails, kitchen knives, needles, saws, light bulbs	- Free (Put in the collection basket disassembled) - Put out lighting fixtures after removing fluorescent tubes - Put out small or broken items in a transparent bag so that the contents can be seen - Put out garbage after removing batteries
Hazardous waste		Spray cans, cassette cylinders, oil stoves, fan heaters, disposable lighters, dry batteries, mercury-based products, fluorescent tubes, lithium-ion batteries, etc., products with built-in lithium-ion batteries, etc., mobile batteries	- Free (Put in the collection basket) - Put products with built-in lithium-ion batteries, mobile batteries, etc., such as dry batteries, lithium-ion batteries, etc. together in one collection basket. - Cracked fluorescent tubes are non-burnable garbage - Put out spray cans and cassette cylinders after using them up without drilling holes
Oversized garbage		Mattresses, beds, sofas, chair-type electric massage machines, tatami mats, furniture, cupboards, futons, carpets, bicycles, skis, water hoses, ropes	- There is a fee (Put out after attaching a large designated sticker) ◆ Oversized garbage300yen (Things made of burnable materials...Items that do not fit in the designated bag, items over one meter) (Items made of non-flammable materials...) (Items larger than 50cm x 50cm x 100cm) 1 sticker ◆ Particularly large objects600yen (The sum of the height + width + depth is 3 m or more.) 2 stickers ◆ Items that require a lot of time to process ...900yen (Spring-loaded mattresses, beds, chair-type electric massage machines, tatami mats, etc.) 3 stickers ★ There is a large garbage door-to-door collection system. (An additional 1,200 yen is required for each item) ※ For more information, please see the guide for sorting and recycling household garbage
Recyclable garbage	Cans 	Food and beverage cans (aluminum cans, steel cans), pet food cans, cans of 1L or less (cans over 1L are non-burnable garbage)	- Free (Put in the collection basket as is) - Empty, rinse with water, and take out - Includes can lids and caps, etc.
	Bottles	Empty jars for food and drink, household medicine bottles, jars for cosmetics	- Free (Divide into separate colors (colorless transparent, brown, and other colors) in the collection basket and put out as is) - Empty and rinse with water before putting out - Caps on bottles (made of aluminum and steel) are non-burnable garbage - The cap of the bottle (made of plastic) is made of plastic
	PET bottles 	For beverages (sake, juice, etc.), for seasonings, for dairy beverages	- Free (put as is in PET bottle collection container) - Remove the cap and label, rinse with water and put out - Put caps and labels in plastics garbage
	Plastics	Plastic bags, trays, packs, cushioning materials, cups, toothbrushes, basins, hangers	- Free (put as is in plastics collection container) - Use up the contents, rinse lightly with water, and put out with the dirt removed - If dirt cannot be removed, put in burnable garbage
	Paper containers and packaging 	Packaging paper, paper boxes, paper bags, mounts, paper cans, paper cartons, milk cartons	- Free (put in the collection container for paper containers and packaging as is) - Use up the contents, rinse lightly with water, and put out with the dirt removed - If dirt cannot be removed, put in burnable garbage
	Newspapers	Newspapers, fold-in flyers	Free (tie it in a bundle using string)
	Magazines	Magazines, catalogs, books, paper, cardboard, calendars, etc. (Not covered: Newspaper, cardboard, vinyl coated paper, carbonless paper, thermal paper, waterproof processed paper)	Free (tie it in a bundle using string)
	Cardboard	Cardboard	Free (tie it in a bundle using string)

Garbage that cannot be collected or brought in	Types of garbage collected	Examples of garbage	Remarks
	Medical garbage	Syringes, needles	Return to a medical institution
	Industrial waste	Demolition garbage from houses, workshops, shops, etc., tiles, block concrete, gypsum board, soil and sand	Have an industrial waste disposal company dispose of it (for a fee)
	Four items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Act	TV (cathode ray tube, liquid crystal, plasma), washing machine, clothes dryer, air conditioner, refrigerator, freezer	Cover the cost necessary for recycling (except for PC recycling marks) and ask a home appliance dealer to pick it up
	Home PC	Desktop computers, displays (cathode ray tubes, liquid crystals), laptops	
	Items that are difficult to properly handle	Petroleum, paints, chemicals (including pesticides), sediment, propane gas cylinders, batteries, fire extinguishers, thinners	
	Other items	Automobile parts, furrow cover plastic sheets for agricultural use, greenhouses, pianos, agricultural equipment such as cultivators, tractors, combines, powered carriers, towing vehicles, etc., solar water heaters, bicycles (including mopeds)	Ask a buyer or processor, etc. to pick it up



- ◆ Please follow local rules and put out your garbage by 8:30 AM on the designated day.
- ◆ We will not recollect garbage that has been put out after collection.
- ◆ Please tie the designated garbage bag properly and take it out to the garbage station.
- ◆ Do not put cans, bottles, non-burnable garbage (glass, ceramics, nails, and other metals) or hazardous garbage (cassette cylinders, spray cans, disposable lighters, dry batteries, mercury-using products, lithium-ion batteries, etc.) in garbage to be burned.
- ◆ Use up the contents of spray cans and cassette cylinders, and put them in hazardous waste without making holes.
- ◆ Take one-time large amounts of garbage (moving garbage, etc.) directly to the Nantan Clean Center or ask a general waste transportation business licensed company to take it.
- ◆ Times when garbage can be taken to the Nantan Clean Center and fee
 - Monday to Friday (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.)
 - ※ Closed on Saturdays, Sundays, holidays, and year-end and New Year holidays
 - 2nd Sunday (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.)
 - Garbage disposal fee: 100 yen per 10 kg
